5. Report of the Director of Corporate Services

5.1 Council Remuneration Review and Recommendations (FIN25-005)

Motion by	Mayor Ritsma
Seconded by	Councillor Nijjar
THAT the Council Re	muneration increase be deferred to 2026.

Committee Discussion: Members of Council and staff held a discussion with respect to the motion. Highlights included:

- there being support for delaying the increase for this year but a caution that the remuneration may affect potential candidates who can fill the role;
- a consideration to approve an increase in the remuneration but leaving the per diem meetings rates the same;
- there being concerns about how a prolonged deferral of the remuneration increase may result in a significant one in the future;
- there being a 3% increase included in the draft 2025 budget and the deferral potentially reducing the budget by approximately \$9,000; and
- how remuneration can attract people to serve on Council and how it can help increase representation in Council particularly for people who may rely on the remuneration to take on the role.

The Chair called the question on the motion.

Motion byCouncillor BeattySeconded byCouncillor HendersonCommittee Decision: THAT Council authorize a 2025 baseremuneration for the Mayor of \$86,800.16, Deputy Mayor of\$24,333.75 and Councillors of \$22,390.14;

THAT the per diem rate for meetings with a duration of three hours or less be increased from \$60 to \$75;

THAT the per diem rate for meetings with a duration of more than three hours in any one day be increased from \$90 to \$150;

THAT Council amend the indexing from the Consumer Price Index to the internal method of following the Administrative Salary Group for any annual increases;

THAT the Council Remuneration By-law attached to Report FIN25-005 be adopted;

AND THAT By-law 20-98 be repealed.
