The City of Stratford will be holding a Household Hazardous Waste collection Saturday, September 7 for residents to drop off materials labelled as corrosive, explosive, flammable or poisonous.

The collection will take place at the Romeo Street landfill site, 777 Romeo Street South, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Trained professionals will be on hand to safely receive things like:

- Paints (please do not bring empty containers), varnish, solvents, caulking, glue
- Fuels, antifreeze, brake fluid
- Used motor oil and filters
- Batteries (household, rechargeable, automotive)
- Household cleaners (i.e. bleach, oven cleaners)
- Energy efficient bulbs, fluorescent tubes/bulbs
- Needles in a puncture-proof container
- Refillable and non-refillable propane tanks
