1. Call to Order

7. New Business

7.1 Design Review of Proposed Downtown Bike Racks (ATAC)

John Lewis, member of the City's Active Transportation Advisory Committee, addressed HS members and presented prototypes and colour options for new bike racks in the downtown core. The heart and circle shaped bike racks will be installed on various poles in the downtown area. This is a joint project between the Downtown BIA and ATAC. Mr. Lewis is looking for approval from the Heritage Committee on the design and colour choice as the racks are being placed downtown in the Heritage Conservation District. They plan to order twelve (12) of the heart-shaped racks and two (2) of the circle racks.
