The seating is made in the Netherlands; several seats have been installed in the Toronto Island Park system and in Ottawa. Zac Gribble indicated that DS was looking at purchasing

approximately 10 chairs which, if approved by the Board, would be installed in clusters of 2 or 3 at several locations along Lake Victoria including some in the area south of the William Hutt bridge and near and/or on Tom Patterson Island. The bright colours of the seating were noted as a concern given the more earth-tone colours of the park and river/lake area. Zac reviewed what options were available and all were bright colours.
